

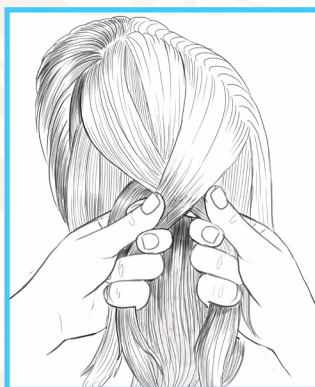
# Feather Braid

There are many ways you can create and wear a Feather Braid. Follow these instructions to create a Feather Braid that is worn with your hair down and the feathery wisps dangling from the length of the left side of the braid. This will create a relaxed, casual look, perfect for hanging out with friends or a day at the beach.

**1** Brush out your hair to ensure there are no knots or tangles, then part your hair to the side.

**2** Take a section of hair from the front of your head on your part line as wide as you want the braid to be. Divide this hair into three equal strands.

**3** Begin plaiting the hair by passing the left-hand strand over the center strand, then the right-hand strand over the new center strand.



**4** Release a small section of hair from the left side of the left-hand strand, then pass the remainder of the left-hand strand over the new center strand. The section you left out will be the first part of your feather.



## Accessorize

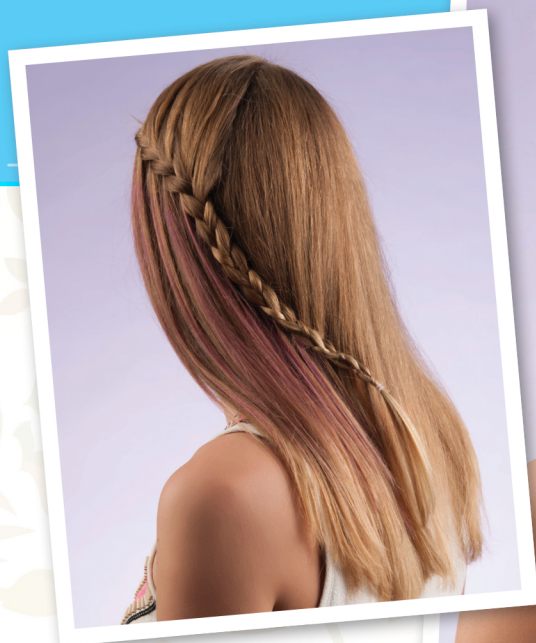
The Feather Braid looks super cool with bright, multicolored, clip-in hair extensions.



## Handy Hint

You can also create a Feathered Waterfall Braid by picking up a new section of hair each time you cross a strand over from the right-hand side.





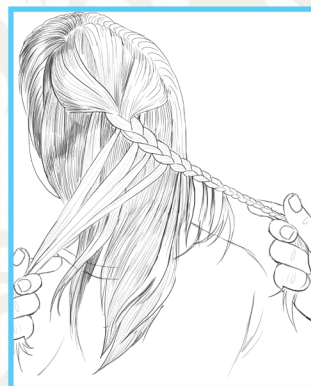
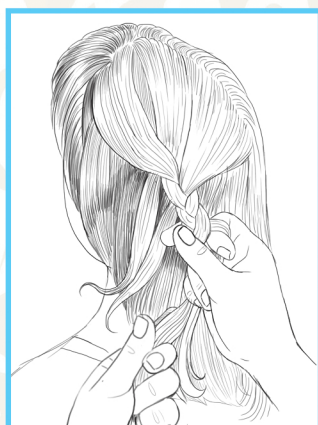
**5** Pass the right-hand strand over the middle strand.

**6** Repeat steps 4–5 until the end, or until the braid becomes too thin to release hair.

**7** Secure with a small, clear hair tie.

### Handy Hint

For a quick and simple braid, use wide strands of hair at each step. Use thinner strands for a more detailed braid.



### Handy Hint

Try coloring over the loose strands of your feather braid with hair chalk for an extra pop!
