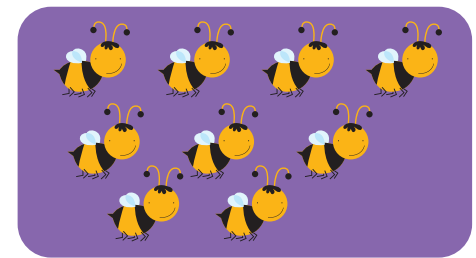




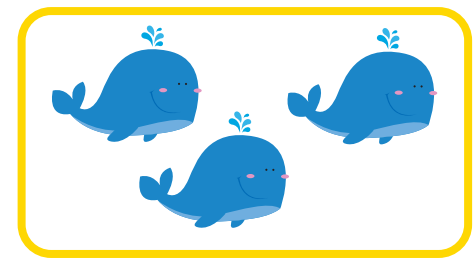


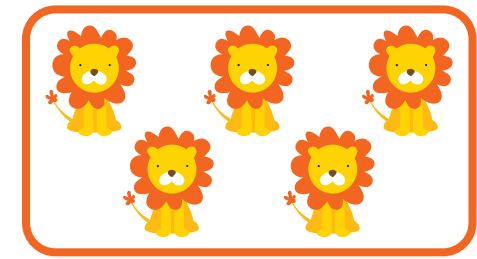


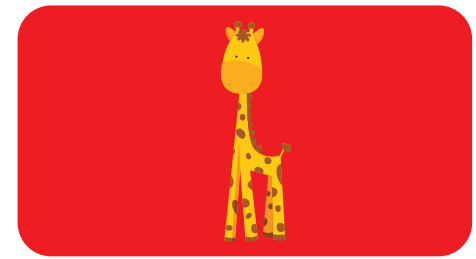














Grammar and Punctuation
